**Camp KEEP is now planning for the 2021-2022 School Year!**

2020-21 has been a unique year of distance learning, but we are pleased to share that despite the challenges, we've served over 9500 students through our virtual camp setting.

Camp KEEP hopes to return students to campus as soon as possible; however it may be a bit longer before we are able to reopen our residential program. We know some will want to return to our in-person experience at the first opportunity, while others may need time for fundraising efforts. In order to support all schools in the upcoming year, we plan to offer both our successful virtual Camp KEEP program and the in-person experience in 2021-22. Please choose ONE of the sign-up options below.

Schools will be scheduled in 21-22 based on the program they choose. All virtual campers will be scheduled first; starting in August and carrying through until requests are filled. Once we have approval from health departments, we will open our camp sites for the traditional in-person experience following the completion of the virtual program. In order to meet the varied needs of our schools, our schedule will be based on district calendars, not requested weeks.
