Health Screening Questions Before Leaving For KEEP

Before allowing participants to board the bus or vehicles for KEEP, school staff must pre-screen all participants (students, counselors, shadows, and teachers) for COVID-19 by taking temperatures and asking the health questions below.

Forehead temperatures must be below 100.4 degrees to attend KEEP. Any participants who answer "Yes" to the following questions may not attend KEEP:

- Do you or your child live with anyone, or have you or your child had close contact with anyone, with a prolonged cough, fever or chills, flu-like symptoms or been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
- Do you or your child live with anyone, or do you or your child have a fever, cough and/or shortness of breath? For children and adults, fever is 100.4 degrees or above using a forehead thermometer.
- Do you or your child live with anyone, or do you or your child have any other signs of communicable illness such as a cold, flu, rash, fatigue, body aches, or inflammation?
- Do you or your child live with anyone or have you or your child experienced diarrhea or vomiting (within the past 24 hours)?
- Have you or your child been exposed to or experienced fatigue, muscle or body aches, headaches, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion, or runny nose?
