KEEP Packing List

REMEMBER to turn these in to your student's teacher on the morning departure:

- ☐ Pre-Trip Health Screening Form
- ☐ All prescription and over-the-counter medications along with their required paperwork.

Luggage: Pack light and remember that duffel bags fit best in our cabins.

Essential Items: Clothes are impossible to keep clean at camp. Please bring only school-appropriate clothing and shoes that you can get dirty, because they will! Label clothes with your name and borrow items you don't own.

Optional Items: Backpack, camera, binoculars, sunglasses, flip flops/Crocs (for showers only), flashlight, and earplugs (for light sleepers).

** Ticks and poison oak are a common and natural part of the ecosystem at camp. We don't recommend pants with holes, crop tops, or ankle socks as they allow access for both. Shorts are never allowed for these reasons.*

Check the Forecast!

Rainy? Bring a poncho/raincoat and extra dry shirts, pants, socks and shoes to change into.

Cold? Bring additional warm layers, gloves and a blanket.
